SUMMARY

Student In The Ministry Joseph Muhammad opens the service, praising Master Muhammad, who is identified as the long-awaited Messiah of the Christians and the Mahdi of the Muslims. He expresses gratitude for the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad, who was spared from divine destruction because he identified Master Fard Muhammad, thus sparing all of humanity. The Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan is presented as the current guide and champion, serving as the embodiment of Master Fard Muhammad and the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad. The audience is instructed to seek assistance through patience and prayer, emphasizing that Allah is with the patient. Joseph Muhammad stresses the need to put on the whole armor of God to stand against the "wiles of the devil" and spiritual wickedness in high places. He closes his introductory remarks by highlighting that desire is the essential "food that builds a will" necessary for enduring difficulty.

Student In The Ministry Tuere Muhammad focuses her message on the historic Million Man March (October 16, 1995), which she describes as a "glimpse of heaven on earth" dedicated to atonement, reconciliation, and responsibility. The March successfully disproved the negative narrative that characterizes black men as violent. She reveals that Minister Farrakhan's call for the March stemmed from a vision-like experience where he was shown that the U.S. government planned a war on two fronts: one against Libya and the second "dealing with the black youth in the streets of America". Tuere Muhammad upholds Minister Farrakhan's role as a divine Warner, citing his warning against the COVID vaccine, stating they were "trying to kill us softly". She concludes that remaining in the spirit of atonement is the path to mend relationships and ensure the mind of Satan dies a natural death among the people. She also references the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad's teaching that a careful study of history is vital, as the "knowledge of the future is judged by the knowledge of the past".

Student Regional Minister Rodney Muhammad delves into the theological and political aspects of the movement. He reminds the audience that they are currently living in the days of Allah, a time when a new government of peace and security is being established. This new government will not be left to the scholars and scientists of the present world, who lack the knowledge to build anything different from what already exists. Rodney Muhammad explores the strategy of the enemy, citing the Holy Qur'an where Iblis (Satan) requests respite and declares, "I will certainly lie in thy straight path" to bring confusion over religion. He identifies fear as the number one weapon used by the enemy to hold the black man back from his destiny. Rodney Muhammad elaborates on the concept of resurrection, clarifying that the Nation of Islam believes in mental resurrection, not physical resurrection. He notes that the term "Negro" derived from the Greek necro (death), referencing the preoccupation with death among their fathers in ancient Egypt, which is why they are "most in need" of this mental resurrection. He affirms that the resurrection process begins with the self accusing spirit, which leads to a moral awakening. He cautions followers to heed the Minister's guidance, ensuring they follow where he directs, because "where he's going, he's able to handle".

Study Guide: Student In The Ministry Joseph Muhammad

- I. Question: Who is Master Muhammad identified as, and for what significant event does Student In The Ministry Joseph Muhammad offer praise and thanks for his appearance?
- Answer: Master Muhammad is identified as the long awaited Messiah of the Christians and the Mahdi of the Muslims. Joseph Muhammad offers thanks for his coming and appearing when the people had fallen to their "all time low," and before he would bring down his total destruction upon us.
- 2. **Question:** In historical instances, Allah typically sends a messenger, prophet, or warner before bringing total destruction. Why, according to Joseph Muhammad, was this method bypassed in their particular case, requiring Master Fard Muhammad himself to come?

- Answer: A messenger or prophet was not sent because their condition was "so deplorable, so wretched" that only Master Fard Muhammad himself could elevate them back to the wonderful position that they had fallen from.
- 3. **Question:** What made the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad (born Elijah Poole) the "most valuable human being that has ever lived" when he identified Master Fard Muhammad?
- Answer: He is considered the most valuable human being to have ever lived on the planet for humanity because he identified who the God was. Because this one man recognized Master Fard Muhammad, all of humanity was spared from the total destruction that God had in His heart to inflict if nobody recognized Him. Elijah Muhammad identified him not because of his physical form, but because how he was represented in the scriptures.
- 4. **Question:** How does Joseph Muhammad describe the relationship between the Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan and the two men who came before him (Master Fard Muhammad and the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad)?
- **Answer:** Minister Louis Farrakhan is presented as the **leader**, **teacher**, **guide**, **friend**, **and champion**. The reason he is said to have "no equal except for the two that [Joseph Muhammad] mentioned before him" is because he is the **embodiment of them**. Therefore, when one sees Farrakhan, one is seeing them.
- 5. **Question:** What two specific actions does Allah instruct believers to seek assistance through in the Holy Qur'an, especially during this time of difficulty?
- Answer: Believers are told to "seek assistance through patience and prayer". Joseph Muhammad notes that Allah is with the patient. Furthermore, he explains that when Allah denies a believer's request, He is actually increasing their patience and building up their will.
- 6. **Question:** According to the scripture cited by Joseph Muhammad (Ephesians), what must believers put on, and what elements does this armor comprise?
- Answer: Believers must "put on the whole armor of God" to stand against the "wiles of the devil" and "spiritual wickedness in high places". This armor includes having loins "girt about with truth," wearing the breastplate of righteousness, feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace, and taking the shield of faith.
- 7. **Question:** According to the study guide passages cited by Joseph Muhammad, what element is identified as the "food that builds a will," and why must this element be kept alive?
- Answer: Desire is the "food that builds a will". The desire to attain a goal brings one face-to-face with difficulty; if the trial is intense, it may extinguish the life of the desire. The light of desire must be kept alive because the will is exercised only as long as desire exists. Continuing perpetual desire generates continuing perpetual exercise of the will.

Study Guide: Student In The Ministry Tuere Muhammad

- I. **Question:** To whom is Student In The Ministry Tuere Muhammad thankful for coming to humanity in the person of Master Fard Muhammad, and who is identified as the divine Warner, guide, and teacher?
- **Answer:** She is grateful to **Allah for coming to us in the person is identified as the divine Warner, guide, and teacher?
- Answer: She is grateful to Allah for coming to us in the person of Master Fard Muhammad, and for raising the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad in knowledge, wisdom, and understanding of our condition. The Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan is identified as a divine Warner guide and teacher.

- 2. Question: When did the Million Man March occur, and what three principles was that day dedicated and devoted to?
- **Answer:** The Million Man March occurred **October 16th, 1995**, and it was dedicated and devoted to **atonement, reconciliation, and responsibility**.
- 3. Question: What negative societal narrative about black men did the Million Man March successfully disprove?
- **Answer:** The March successfully disproved the narrative that black men and youth are **violent and beyond repair**.
- 4. **Question:** According to Minister Farrakhan's vision-like experience in September 1985, what two fronts was the U.S. government planning a war on, which ultimately led to the call for the Million Man March?
- **Answer:** The Minister was shown that the U.S. government had planned a war on two fronts: one against **Libya**, and the second **''dealing with the black youth in the streets of America''**.
- 5. **Question:** What specific, recent plot against Black America did Minister Farrakhan warn against, according to Tuere Muhammad?
- Answer: He gave a warning against the COVID vaccine, stating that the government was "trying to kill us softly with a vaccine".
- 6. Question: What spiritual benefit does Tuere Muhammad emphasize will occur as long as believers remain in the continuous cycle of atonement, reconciliation, and responsibility?
- Answer: As long as followers "stay in the spirit of atonement, reconciliation, and responsibility," the "mind of Satan will die a natural death among us".
- 7. **Question:** Based on the wisdom cited from the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad, what is the connection between the knowledge of the past and the knowledge of the future?
- Answer: The Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad taught that a "careful study of the past events of ancient and modern history" is valuable, and that the "knowledge of the future is judged by the knowledge of the past".

- 2. **Question:** After Master Fard Muhammad's departure, what campaign did the opposition launch, and what did they attempt to replace him with?
- **Answer:** They launched a **harassment campaign** against followers, asking where he was. After failing to get a satisfactory answer, they came up with somebody they said was him, even circulating a police record that listed him being in jail for selling drugs, and they told the world this was the man who started the Nation of Islam.
- 3. **Question:** According to the teachings, what minimum duration was Master Fard Muhammad expected to remain with the people, and why is his continued absence from their records significant?
- **Answer:** According to what they were taught, he would be with them a minimum of **400 years**. His continued unrecorded status is significant because the enemy can find everybody else but they cannot find him.

- 4. **Question:** What unique status did the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad hold, demonstrating a 100% conversion, and what was the consequence of this conversion for those wishing to see the Master?
- **Answer:** Elijah Muhammad was Master Fard Muhammad's **first convert**. If a 100% conversion had taken place, those who wanted to see the Master only had to **look at Elijah**.
- 5. **Question:** Regarding divine guidance, what is the crucial distinction Rodney Muhammad makes between where Minister Farrakhan is going and where followers should go?
- Answer: Followers should go where Minister Farrakhan tells them to go and stop trying to go where he is going. This is because where he's going, he's able to handle it, but followers trying to go there will find out they cannot handle it.
- 6. **Question:** Outside of deception, what is identified as the only real weapon the enemy possesses, and what did the Honorable Elijah Muhammad say was holding the black man back from his destiny?
- **Answer:** The only real weapon they have is **fear**. The Honorable Elijah Muhammad said that **fear is the number one thing** on the list holding the black man back from his destiny.
- 7. **Question:** When the enemy decided to attack Minister Farrakhan, what was their specific goal regarding Negro leadership?
- **Answer:** They wanted to **display him before Negro leadership** in this country, with the goal of showing "Watch what we do to him," as he was supposed to be finished, thereby creating fear among others.
- 8. **Question:** Rodney Muhammad contrasts the "last day" with the current period. What period are they currently living in, and why must the concept of a "last day" apply only to Satan's reign?
- **Answer:** They are currently **living in the days of Allah**. Allah cannot have a last day because he is unlimited. Therefore, the day before Allah's day came was the **last day of Satan**.
- 9. **Question:** What is the nature of the new government being established, and why will it not be left to the scholars and scientists of the present world?
- Answer: It is a foundation for a new government of peace and security for the righteous. It will not be left to the scholars and scientists of this wicked world because they do not have the knowledge to build anything different from what they have already built.
- 10. **Question:** What form of resurrection does the Nation of Islam believe in, and how is this concept supported by the Book of Romans?
- **Answer:** They believe in **mental resurrection**, not physical resurrection. This is supported by the Book of Romans, which states that the **sinful mind is death**, while the **mind filled up with the Spirit of God is life**.
- 11. **Question:** What is the origin of the term "Negro," according to Rodney Muhammad, and what was it originally meant to describe?
- **Answer:** It came from the Greek word *necro*, meaning **death**. The ancient Greeks used it because they saw the black fathers in Egypt preoccupied with death (building tombs, etc.). The term referred to the **state of their dead mind**, not the color of their skin.
- 12. **Question:** Why are the so-called Negroes considered "most in need" of mental resurrection, and who did the Honorable Elijah Muhammad say would be resurrected first?

• Answer: They are considered "most in need" of mental resurrection because their mind was "dead". The Honorable Elijah Muhammad said that since they were the most in need, they will be resurrected first .
13. Question: According to Minister Farrakhan, what begins the process of resurrection, and what must believers do if they desire to stay alive spiritually?
• Answer: The resurrection is that process that begins with the self accusing spirit . If followers desire to stay alive spiritually, they must never steal the voice of Allah from within .
