SUMMARY

This lecture delivers an urgent warning regarding the economic and social decline of the United States while emphasizing the divine nature of the leadership provided by the Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan and the required path of self-improvement for believers.

Student In The Ministry Joseph Muhammad opens by giving praise to Master Fard Muhammad and the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad, hailing Minister Louis Farrakhan as the "most famous Muslim in the planet" and the long-awaited Messiah/Mahdi. He provides comfort, assuring the family that despite worldwide turmoil, the future belongs to the believers. Citing Minister Farrakhan's A Torch Light for America, he highlights the current state of America's economy as being in "grave disrepair" and decline. He notes the all-time low of the stock market (Nov 7–10, 2025) and discusses the spiritual meaning of Surah 105 (The Elephant) related to the confusion of the elite. He warns that America exhibits signs of a "third world country," including economic hardships, costly wars, environmental problems, and governmental "gridlock politics" that blames the poor. He reminds the audience that constant prayer acts as a "booster pill" to help overcome difficulties and encourages consistency in their attendance at the mosque.

Student In The Ministry Tuere Muhammad focuses on the physical and economic health crisis facing the people. She highlights the widespread presence of toxic chemicals in common products like nail polish, perfume, and hairspray, which are linked to aggressive breast cancer, especially among Black women, noting that most cancers stem from environmental and lifestyle factors rather than genetics. She points out that the destructive, unhealthy lifestyles promoted by "Merchants of Death" are often supported by the U.S. government and the medical community. As a holistic remedy that cleanses the body and blood of impurities, she advocates for fasting (3 to 90 days), calling it a superior and free alternative to expensive treatments like chemotherapy and radiation. Furthermore, she exposes the cycle of chemical injustice found in dollar stores, which rely on the purchasing power of low-income and non-white families. The low cost of goods is partially tied to the use of U.S. prison labor (which disproportionately affects people of color and is protected by the 13th Amendment's exception to slavery) in the supply chains of popular food and consumer brands. Finally, she stresses the necessity for Black people to shift from being mere consumers to producers, citing historical abuses (like the failure of the Freedman's Bank and Jim Crow laws) that criminalized Black enterprise.

Student Regional Minister Rodney Muhammad centers his discussion on the nature of divine leadership and persistence. He extols Minister Farrakhan as an "example of a non-quitter," defining true success as the journey, not the destination. He analyzes the challenging assignment of the "recipient of revelation," noting that God often chooses the "despised and rejected" (like the Honorable Elijah Muhammad). He explains that prophets like Jesus and Muhammad ibn Abdullah were "signs" pointing toward the final fulfillment in the present time. The true "seal of the prophets" is the one who does not bring more scripture but reveals the deepest meaning and essence of previous teachings, enabling followers to never need another teacher again—a role fulfilled by Minister Farrakhan. This figure acts as a "light giving sun" whose magnetic energy thaws out "frozen" thinking and implants the wisdom of God for protection and success. SRM Muhammad updates the warnings of economic collapse, citing mass white-collar layoffs (2 million unemployed) driven by Al and automation, predicting that this desperation will lead to anarchy and revolution, comparing the current situation to the French Revolution where the common people violently rose against the aristocracy. He highlights the political significance of the Muslim mayor-elect in New York City (Ma'am Danny) as proof that the establishment is "at war with Islam". Ultimately, the goal is for the followers to stand "living perpendicular," carrying the burden of bringing into existence a new government by solving their own problems and practicing self-discipline.

Study Guide: Student In The Ministry Joseph Muhammad

Question: Who does Student In The Ministry Joseph Muhammad identify as the long-awaited Messiah of the Christians and the Mahdi of the Muslims, and what unique quality made the Honorable Elijah Muhammad a wise choice for the mission?

Answer: The long-awaited Messiah of the Christians and the Mahdi of the Muslims is identified as the **Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan**. SIM Joseph Muhammad also expresses thanks for Master W. Fard Muhammad's wise choice in the **Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad**, a "Georgia born giant". The unique quality was that the Honorable Elijah Muhammad came "right from among us", enabling him to understand the day-to-day struggles of the people and qualify him as a spiritual, psychological, and even physical doctor to aid them.

Question: According to Minister Farrakhan's monumental book, A *Torch Light for America*, what is the overall condition of the U.S. economy?

Answer: Citing Minister Farrakhan's work, A *Torch Light for America*, SIM Joseph Muhammad states that the health of the economy, the American standard of living, and the development of the people are all in a **state of decline**. At present, the U.S. economy is in a state of **grave disrepair**.

Question: What specific economic fluctuation did SIM Joseph Muhammad highlight as evidence of elite confusion, referencing Surah 105 (The Elephant)?

Answer: He highlighted that the stock market had reached an all-time low between November 7th and November 10th, 2025. He connected this decline to the meaning of Surah 105 (The Elephant), noting that Allah caused the war of the "possessors of the elephant" (referencing Republicans) to end in a confusion.

Question: How does America finance its federal debt, and what negative effect does this practice have on government accounts intended for the people?

Answer: The federal debt is primarily financed by issuing government securities (such as treasury bills and savings bonds). About one-third of the total federal debt is financed by surpluses in government accounts such as **Social**Security, railroad retirement insurance, and pension funds. This means America has written checks against what it had promised to set aside for the future of its people, often spending the money processing wars abroad.

Question: What are three signs that indicate America is entering or has entered the state of a "third world country," drawing from historical comparisons to ancient Egypt and the Roman Empire?

Answer: Signs drawing from the decline of Egypt and Rome include: Economic Hardships and Foreign Control (selling bonds and securities to foreign powers, leading to foreign ownership of U.S. assets), Political Instability and Corruption (governmental "gridlock politics" where leadership cannot agree and scapegoats the poor), and Costly Wars and Depleted Treasury (heavy taxes and military overspending, leading to a depleted public treasury).

Question: What type of solutions does Minister Farrakhan suggest are necessary, given America's "desperate condition"?

Answer: Given America is "on her deathbed" and cannot afford a long, protracted treatment for her ills, Minister Farrakhan indicates that the crisis requires **radical solutions**. SIM Joseph Muhammad notes that if a person comes with a realistic solution, they are often immediately called "radical".

Question: What spiritual advice does SIM Joseph Muhammad give to believers regarding their energy and the future?

Answer: He assures believers that the **future belongs to them**. He advises coming to the mosque as a way to **recharge** the energy that the world drains from them. Furthermore, he advises the consistent use of **prayer**, referring to it as a **"booster pill"** that they can take anytime without overdosing to help them navigate difficult times.

Question: According to the information shared by SIM Tuere Muhammad, what is the primary cause of the high rates of aggressive breast cancer, particularly among Black women?

Answer: While only 5 to 10% of breast cancer cases are inherited, the vast majority of cases arise from **environmental and lifestyle factors**. This includes exposure to **toxic chemicals** found in common consumer products like lotion, nail polish, perfume, and hairsprays.

Question: What specific class of toxic chemicals found in everyday personal care products was highlighted as significantly increasing the risk of the most common type of breast cancer?

Answer: The study cited found that women with highly exposure to **phillys** (phthalates), which are used in products such as nail polish, perfumes, and hairsprays, had nearly double the risk of developing estrogen receptors positive breast cancer. Reversing the activity of cancer-related genes was observed when women stopped using these products for only 28 days.

Question: What inexpensive, holistic practice is advocated by SIM Tuere Muhammad (citing the Honorable Elijah Muhammad's *How to Eat to Live*) as a superior way to eliminate accumulated poison from the body?

Answer: She advocates for **fasting** (from 3 days to 90 days). Fasting is a **free**, holistic treatment that cleanses the blood of impurities, eliminates stored poison, and promotes the whole body's health, making it a better alternative to expensive cancer treatments like radiation or chemotherapy.

Question: What are dollar stores cited as perpetuating, and why do low-income and non-white families disproportionately rely on them?

Answer: Dollar store chains are contributing to a cycle of chemical injustice. Low-income and non-white families rely on them as their only option to afford various household necessities and desires within their budget due to the lowest retail prices on the market. However, 53% of tested products sold in dollar stores contain at least one toxic chemical.

Question: Beyond low-quality ingredients, what hidden system is tied to the low prices of major retail chains like dollar stores and Walmart, and why is this system legally permitted?

Answer: The low cost is partly due to the use of **U.S. prison labor**. Goods linked to prisoners, who are often people of color disproportionately affected by the industrial complex, wind up in the supply chains of popular food and consumer brands (like Frosted Flakes and Coca-Cola). This labor is considered legal because of the **I3th Amendment** to the U.S. Constitution, which outlawed slavery *except* as a punishment for a crime.

Question: According to Minister Farrakhan's teachings on economics, what historical forces caused Black people to become a "nation of consumers" rather than producers?

Answer: This was a learned behavior stemming from slavery and the subsequent sharecropping system. Historical abuses included the draining of the Freedman's Bank accounts (worth \$5.8 billion today), leaving tens of thousands in economic ruin, and the institution of Jim Crow Laws, which systematically worked to return Black people to servitude by criminalizing Black business enterprise (e.g., making it illegal to sell property or farm goods without Caucasian permission).

Question: What three crucial questions does SIM Tuere Muhammad advise believers to ask themselves before making any purchase?

Answer: Before spending money, one should ask:

- 1. Is this purchase a want or a necessity?
- 2. Does this product contain any **harmful chemicals** that will negatively impact my health?
- 3. Does this business or corporation I am patronizing or purchasing from **negatively impact or advocate against the progress** of myself and my people?

Study Guide: Regional Student Minister Rodney Muhammad

- I. Question: How does Student Regional Minister Rodney Muhammad define success in life, drawing from the example of Minister Louis Farrakhan? **Answer:** He states that Minister Farrakhan is an "example of a non-quitter". Success in life is **not the destination**, but rather the **journey**. Furthermore, successful people are those who meet and overcome all obstacles in their path and **solve their problems**.
- 2. **Question:** When discussing the "Recipient of Revelation," why does God often bypass the privileged, intellectual, or polished class when choosing a messenger? **Answer:** SIM Muhammad points out that our minds are bent toward a privileged, intellectual, or polished class. However, the Holy Qur'an indicates that **Allah has made some excel others** in means of subsistence, reminding us that Allah is the "best knower". Historically, God chooses the **"despised and rejected"**. If a person could handle the weight of the assignment, God would have chosen them to teach.
- 3. **Question:** According to SIM Rodney Muhammad's teaching, what critical difference is made between historical prophets like Jesus and Muhammad ibn Abdullah, and the figure coming at the end of the present world? **Answer:** SRM Muhammad teaches that the Jesus of 2,000 years ago and Muhammad ibn Abdullah were "**signs**", pointing in the direction of the ultimate reality or fulfillment. They were prophets, but the Messiah/Mahdi was prophesied to come at the end of the world. The conclusion of God's plan was not to be seen in their time, but they were given vision to see down the "wheel of time".
- 4. Question: What does the phrase "The Seal of Prophets" mean, as taught by the Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan, and how is it achieved? Answer: The seal of the prophets is not someone who receives more scripture, but rather someone who God reveals Himself to. There is no seal of prophets until you can teach a people in a way so they never need another teacher again. This figure takes the follower into the essence of the Scripture and its writing, into the spirit of the writer/revelator, allowing them to gain the deepest possible meaning of the word.
- 5. **Question:** What specific, contemporary event in New York City was highlighted as evidence that the establishment is "at war with Islam"? **Answer:** The election of the Muslim mayor-elect, **Ma'am Danny**, in New York City was highlighted. They attempted to stop him, offering money to opponents to stack votes against him. A movement has begun to try and use the Supreme Court to rule that he couldn't be mayor, demonstrating that Islam is only being "tolerated" and that the establishment is "at war with Islam".
- 6. Question: What is the consequence of America's ongoing economic collapse, particularly among the white-collar working class, according to the warnings given by Minister Farrakhan? Answer: The collapse is evidenced by 2 million white-collar workers (who have undergrad and post-grad degrees) being out of work, primarily due to Al and automation. When people cannot find bread, anarchy sets in, leading to people breaking into homes and rising up against constituted authority.
- 7. **Question:** What historical event was used as an analogy to describe the potential violence and lack of mercy that will occur when the impoverished rise up against the rich in America? **Answer:** The **French Revolution** (The Tale of Two Cities) was cited. When the common people rose up after being starved, they established a **"no mercy rule,"** sentencing the aristocracy, their families, and even their servants to the **guillotine**.

- 8. Question: What spiritual advice does SRM Rodney Muhammad offer to believers who secretly question God regarding their suffering despite being righteous? **Answer:** He acknowledges that believers often question why they are suffering when they serve God, pay taxes, and give charity. However, he notes that God will be **with us through everything**, meaning we will **never suffer the absence of Him**. He uses the example of Abraham, who was the friend of God and kept questioning God's judgment until God yielded.
- 9. **Question:** What is the meaning of the description of the prophet as a "**light giving sun**" found in the Holy Qur'an (Sura 33:45)? **Answer:** A prophet is a light giving sun because:
 - It gives light for sight.
- The sun's heat **thaws out things that were frozen** (such as old habits, self-destructive ways of thinking, and false teaching).
 - The rays symbolize the wisdom of God, planting vitamins deep into the body to rise up against diseases.
 - The electromagnetic properties make the man **magnetic**, drawing people to the energy of God.
- 10. Question: What is the significance of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad being at the police headquarters during the confrontation in 1935, and what happened when the brothers were released? **Answer:** When the fight broke out due to the police disrespecting the sister, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad was down there with them and active; they did not have to go back to report to him. When the brothers were released after the conflict, a police captain died of "cardiac arrest" (due to "Allah's hand"), but when the next meeting was set up, none of the brothers showed up in the temple because they were afraid of the consequences.
- II. Question: What is meant by God raising the despised and rejected from a "dead level to a living perpendicular"? Answer: This refers to the secret Masonic language of standing upright at 90 degrees (on the square). The living perpendicular signifies carrying the weight of your own existence, meaning the people must solve their own problems (like knowing gardening, farming, and sewing). Furthermore, upon rising, God places on their shoulders "the burden of bringing into existence a new government".
- 12. Question: What does SRM Muhammad teach about the required training process for believers, contrasting the desire to achieve success with the necessity of learning defined principles? **Answer:** He asserts that people can love the word, but the only place they can take the next step to be anything like what Minister Farrakhan is saying is in the **training classes** (such as the MGT class). Without teaching and training, people are merely "living on **colloquialisms** and phrases". Success is not a destiny chosen, but a set of **habits** acquired through discipline and training.
