SUMMARY

“The Judgment and the Divine Ultimatum”

1. **Question: What is a divine ultimatum?**
Answer: A divine ultimatum is a final warning or demand from God before judgment is carried out. It gives individuals and nations an opportunity to change their conduct before suffering the consequences of continued rebellion.
2. **Question: Why did Minister Joseph connect current events with scripture?**
Answer: He explained that scripture should help us understand what is happening in the present. Prophecies concerning perilous times, corruption, war, and moral decline become meaningful when we recognize their fulfillment in current world conditions.
3. **Question: What evidence was given that perilous times are already present?**
Answer: The lecture pointed to war, corruption, violence, moral confusion, political disorder, injustice, and the rejection of God's guidance as evidence that humanity is living in the time of judgment.
4. **Question: What must Black people do to avoid being destroyed with a corrupt world?**
Answer: They must wake up to the knowledge of self and God, reform their lives, separate from sinful behavior, stop supporting injustice, and align themselves with divine truth and righteousness.
5. **Question: What final choice did Minister Joseph place before the listener?**
Answer: The listener must decide where he or she will stand when judgment comes. Each person must choose truth over falsehood, righteousness over corruption, and obedience to God over participation in a dying world.

STUDY GUIDE

BROTHER ZEBULON X

“Justice and the Coming of Divine Guidance”

1. **Question: How was justice defined in the lecture?**

Answer: Justice was described as the great principle of fair dealing. It requires giving every person what is rightfully due and correcting conditions produced by oppression, exploitation, and unfair treatment.

2. **Question: Why is justice necessary for peace?**

Answer: Peace cannot exist where people are being mistreated. Injustice creates anger, suffering, conflict, and instability. Justice restores balance and creates the conditions for genuine peace.

3. **Question: Why does a suffering people need a divine guide?**

Answer: A people who have been mentally, spiritually, economically, and socially oppressed need guidance beyond the system that produced their oppression. A divine guide restores identity, direction, discipline, and knowledge of God.

4. **Question: How was America compared to Egypt?**

Answer: America was presented as a modern Egypt because Black people were brought into bondage, robbed of identity, and subjected to centuries of oppression. As ancient Israel needed deliverance, Black people in America require divine liberation.

5. **Question: What role does Master Fard Muhammad have in the teaching presented?**

Answer: He is presented as the long-awaited divine guide who came to awaken and deliver Black people, raise the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad, and establish the work that became known as the Nation of Islam.

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STUDENT REGIONAL MINISTER RODNEY MUHAMMAD

“Transition”

1. **Question: What does transition mean spiritually?**

Answer: Spiritual transition is movement from ignorance to knowledge, darkness to light, weakness to strength, dependence to self-mastery, and an old identity into the person God intended us to become.

2. **Question: What lesson was taught through the example of the sun and the seed?**

Answer: A seed may contain life, but it needs the proper environment and the power of the sun to germinate. Likewise, the human being contains divine potential that must be awakened by truth, guidance, discipline, and the light of God.

3. **Question: What is the responsibility of a true shepherd?**

Answer: A true shepherd must feed the people with truth, protect them from danger, guide them in the right direction, correct them when necessary, and help them grow into responsible servants of God.

4. **Question: Why did Minister Rodney emphasize that God is not distant?**

Answer: He wanted the audience to understand that God does not remain removed from human suffering. God intervenes in history, raises servants, reveals guidance, judges evil, and works through chosen human beings to transform society.

5. **Question: How does a person successfully move through transition?**

Answer: A person must release the habits and beliefs of the old world, accept divine guidance, develop a new mind, remain faithful during discomfort, and courageously step into his or her God-given identity and purpose.

KEYNOTE STUDY GUIDE

THE HONORABLE MINISTER LOUIS FARRAKHAN

Discipline, Divine Power, Humility, Nonaggression, and Self-Acceptance

1. **Question: What did the martial arts demonstration symbolize to Minister Farrakhan?**

Answer: It symbolized disciplined strength, control of the mind and body, courage, balance, concentration, and power that is governed by intelligence rather than aggression.

2. **Question: Why did Minister Farrakhan call the body the house of God?**

Answer: God desires to live and work through the human being. Caring for the body through proper diet, exercise, discipline, cleanliness, and self-respect prepares the body to serve as a worthy instrument of God.

3. **Question: What is the relationship between physical discipline and spiritual development?**

Answer: Physical discipline teaches patience, control, endurance, courage, concentration, and obedience. These same qualities are required for spiritual growth and the mastery of one's lower desires.

4. **Question: Why did Minister Farrakhan say that a great minister must first become a great follower?**

Answer: A student cannot properly lead until he or she has learned to listen, obey, study, sacrifice, and submit to a qualified teacher. Faithful following prepares the student to carry the teacher's mission without being corrupted by ego.

5. **Question: How can vanity rob a student of power?**

Answer: Vanity causes a student to focus on personal praise, position, appearance, and desire rather than the purpose of the teacher. This separates the student from the source of guidance and weakens the power that comes through obedience.

6. **Question: What did Minister Farrakhan teach about Jesus and Muhammad?**

Answer: He taught that both represent submission to God and the development of the human being into oneness with divine purpose. The names should not be used to divide believers but studied for the qualities of obedience, truth, sacrifice, and service that they represent.

7. **Question: What does it mean to become one with God?**

Answer: It does not mean that the human being becomes the Creator of the universe. It means that the servant increasingly submits his or her thoughts, words, desires, and actions to God until the Will of God is reflected through that person.

8. **Question: What lesson did Minister Farrakhan share concerning Mother Khadijah Farrakhan?**

Answer: He honored her love, sacrifice, companionship, strength, and contribution to his life and mission. He taught that a righteous person's presence and influence can continue even after physical death.

9. **Question: How did the example of a dying star explain continuing influence after death?**

Answer: A star may no longer physically exist, yet its light continues traveling through space. In the same way, the truth, love, work, and example of a righteous servant can continue enlightening people long after that person has departed.

10. **Question: What is divine science?**

Answer: Divine science is knowledge of the laws, forces, and powers placed in creation by God. When the

mind and body are disciplined and brought into harmony with those laws, human beings may demonstrate abilities that appear extraordinary.

11. Question: Why did Minister Farrakhan warn people not to imitate advanced demonstrations without preparation?

Answer: The demonstrations required years of training, mental control, bodily conditioning, knowledge, and qualified instruction. Attempting them without preparation would be foolish and dangerous.

12. Question: Why did Minister Farrakhan say that an aggressor is a loser?

Answer: An aggressor acts from arrogance, fear, greed, or the desire to dominate. God does not support oppression, tyranny, bullying, or unjust warfare. Aggression eventually produces consequences for the aggressor.

13. Question: What warning was given to nations that trust in military weapons?

Answer: Ships, bombs, missiles, armies, and nuclear weapons cannot protect a nation that opposes God. The forces of nature are greater than military technology, and God can use those forces to defeat aggressors.

14. Question: What danger is attached to praise and personal gifts?

Answer: Praise can blind a gifted person and cause him or her to forget the Giver of the gift. When pride replaces gratitude and service, the gift can become destructive and place the person under the influence of Satan.

15. Question: What did Minister Farrakhan mean by “accept your own and be yourself”?

Answer: He was calling the listener to stop imitating others, reject false identities, recognize the gifts and nature given by God, accept responsibility for personal development, and become the unique servant God intended that person to be.
